It's going to be "A Fair to Remember!" at the Florence County Fair. The Florence County Fair returns again for its 114th annual engagement in 2017 and once again promises family-friendly fun and entertainment for kids of all ages.



A Little Background Information:
The Fair highlights the agricultural and natural resources of Florence County. In addition, it provides a venue to showcase the many and varied talents of the residents in our County. During the three days of the fair, there is an increased amount of traffic through the entire county, which provides visitors with exposure to our community and what we have to offer. The fair also provides businesses and community organizations with the opportunity to have a booth at the fair in order to promote themselves to the fair attendees from throughout the immediate area, the state, and the country. The fair is organized and staffed completely by volunteers.

In addition to the fair itself, over the last few years the fair board with the help of generous donors, volunteers, and local businesses has made big changes to the fair park including:

- ⇒ A new roof on the exhibit building
- ⇒ A Timber Cut
- ⇒ A brand-new beer stand, second stage and pavilion
- ⇒ A new speaker system for the arena
- ⇒ New playground equipment

The Florence County Fair Board strives to make the fair a family-friendly community-oriented event. Those attending the fair, only pay for an admission wristband which is good for the entire weekend.
